

Explosive Ordnance contamination problem in Ukraine. Needs in the field of Mine Action




On February 24, 2022, the russian federation launched a full-scale invasion of Ukraine with the use of all types of weapons



160 000 sq. km of potentially contaminated lands and 14 000 sq. km of water areas must be surveyed



More 6 million people live near hazardous areas





More 50% incidents in Kharkiv, Kherson and Mykolaiv regions 75% incidents with mines 25% incidents with ERW








NTS covered 80 hromads with area 40 000 sq. km

18 operators were completed accreditation to provide MA activities in Ukraine.


29 organizations and 19 governmental units in process of accreditation.






in the case of the formation of government units for humanitarian demining, the effectiveness of land-release processes will increase to 60 square kilometers per year


